- > The offline class and online classes (Blended Mode) for all diploma classes (except for first year) is scheduled from 1st September 2021. Students should come with due preparation to attend the classes.
- > Instructions regarding commencement of first year classes in online mode will be informed later.
- > Students are instructed to attend the classes with uniform and decent hair style. In case students do not have their uniform ready, they are permitted to attend the classes with formal dress and shoes for a period of one week.
- > Students coming to college are instructed to bring their Permanent/Temporary identity card issued during the time of admission.
- > The students coming to the college are instructed to follow the Standard operating Procedure (SoP) listed below:
- > Students from other states shall have to comply with the conditions specified by the Government of Tamilnadu with regard to entry into Tamilnadu.
- > Every Student is required to submit a No Objection Certificate from parents in the prescribed format and submit it in the Hostel (hosteller) or in the concerned Department (day scholar) on the first day of reporting
- > Every student will be subjected to thermal screening when he/she enters the college/hostel.
- > At the time of joining the hostel, students should bring adequate number of N95 masks/3 plyface masks, face shields, hand sanitizers, hand tissues, laptops/tabs/mobiles with internet connection, dining plates, tumblers, water bottles, etc.
- > Food can be taken in the hostel mess or can be carried to their rooms in carriers. Hostel charges will be levied on monthly basis. The details of fees are available as below.
- > Students shall wear face mask/shield always, wash their hands with soap/sanitizer frequently and maintain social distancing.
- > Students showing any COVID related symptoms shall have to isolate themselves at home and at hostel after informing the Warden. If necessary, they will be referred to the PSG Hospitals.
- > Students should follow the guidelines, advisories and instructions issued by government authorities as well as by the college regarding health and safety measures in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

## Hostel fee structure on daily basis per student

> Students those who are already staying in the hostel are informed to pay Rs.12,000 as demand draft (DD) drawn in the name of "PSG Tech Hostel" payable at Coimbatore.

Hostel fees details:

- ➤ Mess and Room Charges = 400\*30 days= Rs.12,000 /-
- > Students those who are requesting Hostel are informed to pay Rs.18,000/- as demand draft (DD) drawn in the name of "PSG Tech Hostel" payable at Coimbatore.

Hostel fees details: (New Admission)

- Application fees: Rs. 1, 000/-
- Caution Deposit: Rs. 5, 000/-
- ➤ Mess and Room Charges Rs.400/-per day(Rs.400\*30 days) = Rs.12,000 /-)
- > Note: Any excess amount paid will be carried forward to the next year hostel expenses.

- 2. Under any circumstances, residents are not permitted to occupy the hostel premises before 31.08.2021 (2.00 PM).

## The following are the important guidelines to be followed during stay at hostel:

- 1. Residents are informed to register their entry including the **travel history** in the hostel main gate by producing the identity card to the security personnel and they are advised to register the same while leaving from hostel after the completion of examinations.
- 2. Residents have toundergothermal screening and sanitation while entering the hostel gate and dining hall.
- 3. Residents shall stay at their own room allocated and not to stay as groups.
- 4. Residents shall maintain social distancing in rooms, dining halls and in the hostel premises to avoid the spread of COVID 19. They are also advised to wear mask, sanitize or wash their hands frequently.
- 5. In case of **any medical emergency**, residents shall contact the block supervisor or resident tutor immediately. The respective student will be taken to **PSG Hospital** for treatment and they are advised not to leave the hostel even for medical reasons on their own.
- 6. Water doctors will be available in the respective blocks and mess; residents are informed to carry their own water bottles and not to share the same with fellow friends.
- 7. Residents are informed to **dine only at the allotted mess**and they are **not permitted** to**dine outside including restaurants** during their stay at hostel.
- 8. For students residing at **PSG Tech Additional hostels**, Transport facility has been arranged from hostel to college (to and fro), residents are informed to **use this facility alone** and advised not to use any other means. Also, strictly adhere to the timings of transport facility which will be informed in due course.
- 9. Students are informed **not to involve in any indisciplinary acts**they may lead to suspension from both hostel and college.
