- ➤ The offline classes for the first year (Second semester) students is scheduled from 1st March 2021 to 20th March 2021 (3 Weeks duration in the first phase). Students should come with due preparation to attend the offline classes.
- > Students are instructed to follow the formal dress code in college, Boys can wear formal shirt, pant and girls can wear chudidhar with dupatta. Students are strictly not allowed to wear T shirts jeans and leggings (Girls).
- > Students coming to college are instructed to bring their identity card issued during the time of admission.
- > During this three weeks period, hostellers are not permitted to leave to their home.
- > However, the second year (Fourth semester) classes are to be continued through online mode until further instructions.
- > The first year students coming to the college are instructed to follow the standard operating procedure (SoP) listed below:
- > Every Student is required to submit a No Objection Certificate from parents in the prescribed format and submit it in the Hostel (hosteller) or in the concerned Department (day scholar) on the first day of reporting.
- ➤ Students will be screened for temperature and SPO₂ every day during morning and evening.
- > At the time of joining the hostel, students should bring adequate number of N95 masks/3 ply face masks, two face shields, hand sanitisers, hand tissues, tiffin boxes/ carriers, laptops/tabs/mobiles with internet connection, dining plates, tumblers, water bottles, etc.
- > They shall ensure that they do not have symptoms like cold, fever etc.
- > Food can be taken in the hostel mess or can be carried to their rooms in carriers. Hostel charges will be levied on monthly basis. The details of fees are available as below.
- > Students shall wear face mask/shield always, wash their hands with soap/sanitiser frequently and maintain social distancing.
- Every student will be subjected to thermal screening when he/she enters the college/hostel.
- > Students showing any COVID related symptoms shall have to isolate themselves at home and at hostel after informing the Warden. If necessary, they will be referred to the PSG Hospitals. Treatment if any will be arranged in PSG Hospitals.
 - > The government orders issued from time to time have to be obeyed fully.

Hostel fee structure on daily basis per student

- > Hostel will be provided for students who request hostel during the time of admission.
- > They are informed to pay Rs. 16,000/- as demand draft (DD) drawn in the name of "PSG Tech Hostel" payable at Coimbatore.

Hostel fees details:

- > Application fees: Rs. 1, 000/-
- > Caution Deposit: Rs. 5, 000/-
- ➤ Mess and Room charges: Rs. 400/- per day. (Rs. 400 X 25 days = Rs. 10, 000/-) Total amount to be paid: Rs. 16, 000/-
- > Note: Any excess amount paid will be carried forward to the next year hostel expenses.
